

Watercolor Techniques

Recommended Supplies

Watercolor Paper: I have tried many and find Arches hot press 140lb to be my go to paper. I suggest a few sheets of size 8X10 or 9X12

Brushes: I like Raphael 8404 sizes 4 and 2

Paint: I use Daniel Smith transparent and permanent colors. These are the colors on my basic palette. If you already have another paint brand use what you have, we will work it out.

- Aureolin
- Hansa Yellow
- Green Gold
- New Gamboge
- Sap Green
- Cobalt Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Prussian Blue
- Transparent Red Oxide
- Moonglow
- Quinacridone Burnt Orange
- Quinacridone Magenta
- Quinacridone Rose
- Quinacridone Purple

Other supplies: Ruler

- Drawing pencils
- Kneaded eraser
- Lights
- Drawing board
- Water container
- Clean rags or paper towels

The supplies on this list are recommended not required. If you have equivalent supplies from the Introduction to Watercolor classes you can use those. The ones I am suggesting here are those that I have found work for me. Sheila Hayden 2024
